

Changes to be included in the Pine-Richland Inline Hockey Association
By-Laws:

Article V: Nominees for the positions will be presented prior to a vote. The election of the Board of Directors shall take place at either the end of season banquet or at a spring general meeting. The members of the entire Association elect all board members with each family having one vote per player. Any open or vacant positions will subsequently be filled by members selected and approved by a majority of the new Board. In the event a Board Member is unable to complete a full term, the Board may fill the vacancy. A person who is an active member in good standing will fill the vacant office. All Board positions shall be a one-year term, but may be renewed if necessary. Only one family member may be represented on the Board.

Article VI, Section II: General Membership Meeting

There will be at least one general membership meeting scheduled during the year.

Article VII, Section IV: The inline program will be governed by the rules of the PIRHL, the Pine-Richland School District and additional guidelines as may be directed by the Board. (See Addendums I, II, and III)

Article VIII, Section V: Each player must read and sign the PRIHA Code of Conduct, as well as the PIRHL Zero Tolerance and Fighting Policies. (See Addendums I and III)

Article VIII, Section VI: Attendance Requirements

In addition to meeting the PIRHL game attendance requirements (See Addendum I), all players must meet practice attendance requirements as established by the Board of Directors of the PRIHA. (See Addendum II).

Article XI: Dissolution of the PRIHA

In the event of dissolution of the PRIHA, any assets remaining after all obligations are met, will be distributed evenly between all members in good standing and/or a 501(C)3 nonprofit organization at the end of the final season.

Addendum II
Attendance Requirements
PRIHA

Attendance at practices is mandatory. In the event that a player misses (1) practice, such player will sit out his/her first shift in the game immediately following the missed practice.

After the third missed practice, the player will be benched for the first period of the game immediately following the missed practices.

After the fifth missed practice, the player will be benched and must be present for the entire game immediately following the missed practices.

An exception can be for a player who misses practices due to extenuating circumstances (which does not include other sporting activities), upon PRIHA Board and coaches' written approval.

Missed practices due to academic ineligibility (as set forth by PRSD) or inclement weather are not subject to these requirements.
